Club Dues & Policies

1. Dues amount for 2011 set at \$10.00 per physical household
2. Deadline for paying membership dues will be by the February club meeting of each year.
3. Memberships in arrears are allowed no greater than 60 days (two meetings).
4. Members in arrears greater than 60 days (two meetings) will be contacted by the President of the club and be asked to pay their membership dues before attending any further meetings.
5. Guests are welcome to attend up to 2 meetings before being asked to join the club.
6. Dues will not be pro-rated regardless of when membership is established.
7. Memberships are for calendar year, January 1 – December 31
8. Discussion to be held at the November meeting whether dues amount needs to be changed for the following year.
9. Although the club is a non-profit group, the intent of the club, through good management, is to build our bank account balance for any and all future needs.
10. Only persons with current membership dues will have voting privileges.
11. Expenditures above \$20.00 will require club approval by simple majority vote of members.
12. Expenditures under \$20.00 must have the prior consent of at least 2 club officers. Email documentation in treasurer's file, of club officer's consent, is sufficient.
13. The club treasurer is authorized to sign checks.
14. Paying memberships beyond the current year will not be permitted.

Election of Officers and Terms of Office

New Officers shall be nominated by paying club members attending the November meeting. The nominations shall be affirmed by a majority vote of the general members. Four Officers shall be nominated: President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Officers will be elected by majority membership vote at the December meeting. The term of office will be one year – from January through December.

If an Officer should resign before his or her term ends or be unable to complete his or her term of office, the President, with concurrence of a majority of the paying members, may replace that Officer for the remainder of the un-expired term until the next election, at which time a replacement will be selected by utilizing the nomination and selection process outlined above.

If the President resigns before the end of his or her term, the Vice President shall assume the role of President, and with concurrence of a majority of the paying members, may replace the Vice President for the remainder of the un-expired term until the next election, at which time a replacement will be selected by utilizing the nomination and selection process outlined above.
